HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 367, L. D. 526, Bill, "An Act Relating
to Definition of Fish Weirs."

Amend said Bill by striking out the 4th, 5th and 6th lines and
inserting in place thereof the following underlined words and
punctuation " 'A weir structure that is not built by the 15th day
of July in any year shall not be considered a weir for the remainder
of the year.' "

Further amend said Bill by inserting the following underlined
words 'catch pound' in the 18th line between the underlined words
"which" and "they".
