AN ACT Increasing Salary of Judge of Ellsworth Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1876, c. 298, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 298 of the private and special laws of 1876, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 150 of the private and special laws of 1955, is further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Salary of judge. The police court of the City of Ellsworth, in the County of Hancock, shall be hereafter styled the Ellsworth Municipal Court. The present judge of said court shall continue in office until the end of the term for which he was elected. The salary of the judge shall be ~~\$2,500~~ \$3,000 per year to be paid out of the county treasury of the County of Hancock in equal monthly payments on the first day of each month.'
