IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Speed of Motor Vehicles on the Maine Turnpike.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1941, c. 69, § 11, sub-§ (b), amended. Subsection (b) of section 11 of chapter 69 of the private and special laws of 1941 is amended to read as follows:

‘(b) The authority may by regulation prescribe a maximum limitation on the speed of vehicles using said turnpike, **but not exceeding 70 miles per hour**, and so limit at any point or place thereon, and is empowered to regulate the volume and weight of vehicles admitted to the turnpike.’
