COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 205, L. D. 544, Bill, "An Act to  
Revise the Inland Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 5, a new section 5-A,  
to read as follows:

"Sec. 5-A.R. S., c. 37, §45, amended. The first 2 paragraphs of  
section 45 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, are  
amended to read as follows:

~~'No person shall take, catch, kill or have in possession more than  
10 fish of the salmon, trout, togue or black bass species in the  
Counties of Franklin and Somerset during any one day of any open sea-  
son, from any or all of the rivers, streams, brooks, lakes and ponds  
in said counties, and which 10 fish shall not exceed a total weight  
of 7½ pounds in all; unless the last fish caught increases the comb-  
ined weight thereof to more than 7½ pounds; except as provided for by  
rules and regulations of the department under section 9.~~

No person shall take, catch, kill or have in possession more  
than 15 fish of the salmon, trout, togue or black bass species in the  
Counties of Aroostook, Androscoggin, Cumberland, Hancock, Kennebec,  
Knox, Lincoln, Oxford, Penobscot, Piscataquis, Sagadahoc, Waldo,  
Washington and York during any one day of any open season, from any  
or all of the rivers, streams, brooks, lakes and ponds in said count-  
ies, ~~and which 15 fish shall not exceed a total weight of 7½ pounds  
in all; unless the last fish caught increases the combined weight  
thereof to more than 7½ pounds,~~ except as provided for by rules and  
regulations of the department under section 9.

No person shall take, catch or kill in any one day or have in  
possession at any time more than 7½ pounds in the aggregate of the  
trout, salmon, togue and black bass species unless the last fish  
caught increases the combined weight to more than 7½ pounds. " "

Further amend said Bill in section 8 by striking out the single  
quotation mark at the end and adding the following underlined para-  
graph:

"Notwithstanding the provisions of this section paraplegics may  
hunt from motor vehicles which remain stationary."

Further amend said Bill in section 16 by inserting before the  
period at the end the underlined words ' or bow and arrow '
