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## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 99th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 205, L. D. 544, Bill, "An Act to

Revise the Inland Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 17 and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 17. R. S., c. 37, §129, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 129 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'All fees, fines and penalties recovered and money received or collected and including moneys received from sale, lease or rental of department owned property shall be paid to the Treasurer of State and credited to the department-of-inland-fisheries-and-game for-the-operation-of-fish-hatcheries-and-feeding-stations-for-fish; for-the-protection-of-fish; game-and-birds; information-and-education on-conservation-and-for-printing-the-report-of-said-commissioner-and other-expenses-incident-to-the-administration-of-said-department, and-shall-be-expended-by-the-said-commissioner-for-the-purposes-for which-said-department-is-ereated General Fund.'

Sec. 17-A. R. S., c. 37, §129, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 129 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is repealed as follows:

'Provided-further;-that-if-any-of-such-fees;-fines;-penalties or-other-moneys-are-not-expended-during-the-year-in-which-they-are collected;-the-unexpended-balance-shall-not-lapse;-but-be-earried as-a-continuing-account-and-available-for-the-purposes-herein specified-until-expended;'"
