COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 217, L. D. 556, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Superintending School Committee of Town of
Freeport."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 3rd and 4th lines of
section 1 the following words: "and shall fill vacancies aris-
ing therein at each subsequent annual town meeting"

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1
the following new sentence: 'A vote of a majority of the full
membership of the committee shall be required for the purpose of
conducting business and exercising the powers of the committee
and for all other purposes.'

Reported by the Committee on Legal Affairs.

Read and adopted in the Senate, March 19, 1959.
