IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Clerk Hire in County Offices in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes which relates to Oxford County, as amended by section 7 of chapter 459 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended to read as follows:

'Oxford County: for clerks in the office of the register of deeds, \$4,000 \$5,000; for clerks in the office of the register of probate, \$2,000 \$2,500; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$2,000 \$2,500.
