**AN ACT Increasing Salary of Judge of Rumford Municipal Court and
Providing Clerk Hire.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1907, c. 429, § 1, amended. The first sentence of section 1 of chapter 429 of the private and special laws of 1907, as last amended by chapter 114 of the private and special laws of 1955, is further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of the Rumford Municipal Court shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$3,500~~ \$4,000, and an annual allowance of \$1,500 for clerk hire, payable monthly out of the county treasury of the County of Oxford, on the first day of each month, which shall be in full payment for his services as such judge.'
