**AN ACT Appropriating Moneys to Construct a Women's Dormitory at the
Aroostook State Teachers' College.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Women's Dormitory at Aroostook State Teachers' College; appropriation. There is appropriated to the Department of Education the sum of \$375,000 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960 for the construction of a Women's Dormitory at Aroostook State Teachers' College. This appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuous carrying account until the purposes of this act have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This dormitory was one of two originally scheduled for the 1961-1963 biennium in the long-range capital improvement plan of the Aroostook State Teachers' College. The addition of a Health and Physical Education curriculum major in the fall of 1958 greatly increased the demand for dormitory accommodations because of an increasing percentage of students coming from other areas. The present housing facilities will be inadequate by the fall of 1959.
