STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Completion of Music Section of Multi-Purpose Building at Aroostook State Teachers' College.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Music section of multi-purpose building; appropriation to complete. There is appropriated to the Department of Education the sum of \$26,750 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960 to complete the music section of the multi-purpose building at Aroostook State Teachers' College.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The purpose of this appropriation is to provide for the addition of music classroom to the auditorium section of the Multi-Purpose Building to complete Dramatic and Music Center originally provided for in the planning of the Multi-Purpose Building.

The Multi-Purpose Building was planned to provide facilities for three phases of the college program e. g. (1) Student Center; (2) Dramatics and Music; (3) Health and Physical Education. When expansion of the curriculum was authorized to include a major in Health and Physical Education, additional emphasis to the improvement of the facilities in that area was necessary. The music classroom was omitted because of appropriation limitations.
