### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Filling Vacancies in Board of School Directors of a School Administrative District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 111-J, amended. The first sentence of the 3rd paragraph from the end of section 111-J of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1-B of chapter 364 and as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 443, both of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'When a vacancy on the Board of School Directors occurs by reason of death, resignation or otherwise, the remaining members of the board shall fill the vacancy by electing a director from the same municipality that the prior director represented, after nomination from the selectmen or municipal officers, to serve until the municipality shall fill the vacancy at its next annual town meeting or next regular city election.'
