RESOLVE Authorizing State Highway Commission to Study Desirability of Bridge Across Saco River.

Bridge across Saco River; study authorized. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make a study of the need and cost of a highway bridge across the Saco River between the Cities of Saco and Biddeford, in the County of York, to provide a continuous coastal route, with necessary highway approaches thereto; and be it further

Resolved: That the commission shall report the results of their study at the next regular session of the Legislature.
