AN ACT Relating to Residence of Judge of Eastport Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1903, c. 219, § 1, amended. The first sentence of section 1 of chapter 219 of the private and special laws of 1903 is amended to read as follows:

‘A municipal court is hereby established in and for the City of Eastport in the County of Washington, which shall be denominated the Eastport Municipal Court, and shall be a court of record, with a seal, and shall consist of one judge who shall be an attorney at law and reside in the legislative district in which said Eastport **Municipal Court is located.**’
