## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 99th LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 397, L. D. 580, Bill, "An Act Repealing Certain Disqualifications of Benefits Under Employment Security Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after paragraph B and inserting in place thereof the following:

'C. Retirement pay or a pension paid, excluding a pension paid under Title II of the Federal Social Security Act, as amended, directly by the employer or paid indirectly by the employer through a trust fund, insurance or other media in the manner set forth in paragraph-B-of-subsection-XIX-of section 3.

subsection XIX, paragraph B, but only if in addition to a retirement pay or a pension paid, he is also being paid a pension under Title II of the Federal Social Security Act, as amended.

If such remuneration under the-provisions-of paragraphs A and C is less than the benefits which would otherwise be due under the provisions-of this chapter, he shall be entitled to receive for such week, if otherwise eligible, benefits reduced by the amount of such remuneration;'
