RESOLVE, Increasing Pension for Mrs. Therese Jacques of Van Buren.

Mrs. Therese Jacques; state pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and is, granted to Mrs. Therese Jacques, of Van Buren, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1959 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of the resolves of 1953, chapter 94, which provided for a state pension for Mrs. Therese Jacques, of Van Buren, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Jacques is a sickly woman and cannot provide for herself. The Town of Van Buren has been providing for her welfare for many years. The town has paid for fuel, groceries, lights, water and medical care.
