**AN ACT Relating to Payment of Expenses, Clerk Hire and Increasing  
Salary of Judge of Lisbon Municipal Court.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1941, c. 51, § 12, repealed and replaced.** Section 12 of chapter 51 of the private and special laws of 1941, as amended by section 1 of chapter 116 of the private and special laws of 1955, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 12. Salary of judge; appropriation for clerk hire. The judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of \$2,000, with \$1,000 additional for clerk hire, from the treasury of said Androscoggin County in weekly payments, which sum shall be compensation in full for the performance of all duties required of said judge by law.’

**Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1941, c. 51, § 13, repealed and replaced.** Section 13 of chapter 51 of the private and special laws of 1941, as amended by section 2 of chapter 116 of the private and special laws of 1955, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 13. County shall provide court room. The County of Androscoggin shall provide a suitable court room, conveniently situated in said Town of Lisbon and appropriately fitted up and furnished, together with a telephone therein and blanks, books, dockets, stationery and all other necessary things, for the use of said court in the conduct of its business. Said county is authorized to appropriate money and expend the same in a sum not exceeding \$800 annually.’
