STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of In-State Bidder in State Bids.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 15-A, § 39, sub-§ IX, amended. Subsection IX of section 39 of chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:
 - 'IX. The phrase "in-state bidder" shall be held to mean one having its principal place of business, or a branch thereof, located in Maine or having a regularly employed representative who is a bona fide resident of the State of Maine.'
