AN ACT Relating to Physical Examination for School Bus Operators.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 13-A, additional. Chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 13-A as follows:

'Sec. 13-A. A Physical examination of school bus operators. No person shall operate a school bus with a seating capacity of 10 or more persons in the actual conveyance of school children until he shall have passed such physical examination as the State Board of Education shall prescribe to determine his physical fitness.'
