IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Stand-By Emergency Power at Gorham State Teachers' College.

Gorham State Teachers' College; appropriation to. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the State the sum of \$6,900 in favor of Gorham State Teachers' College to construct shelter for stand-by power unit and to make electrical connections to Central Maine Power Company service. Funds appropriated under this resolve shall be expended on recommendation of the State Board of Education and approved by the Governor and Council; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A 75-KVA diesel generator unit has been acquired through surplus property agencies. This appropriation is for the purpose of providing housing for the unit and for making necessary electrical connections to existing facilities.

The unit is sufficiently large enough to provide emergency power to all heating plants as protection against costly freeze-ups in the event of line power loss during winter months.
