STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for an Industrial Arts Building at Gorham State Teachers' College.

Gorham State Teachers' College; appropriation to. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the State the sum of \$582,900 in favor of Gorham State Teachers' College to construct an industrial arts building for general metalwork, general electricity, general woodwork, transportation, general shop, graphic arts, general crafts, technical drawing, classrooms, administrative areas and storage facilities. Funds appropriated under this resolve shall be expended on recommendation of the State Board of Education and approved by the Governor and Council; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Present facilities are inadequate, unsafe, antiquated and uneconomical and are located in 4 separate buildings. The industrial arts building would provide modern, adequate classrooms, shops and auxiliary facilities.
