**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Primary Voltage Distribution
System at Gorham State Teachers' College.**

Gorham State Teachers' College; appropriation to. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the State the sum of \$33,000 in favor of Gorham State Teachers' College to put the high voltage electric distribution lines to all future buildings underground and connect to present building underground distribution lines. Funds appropriated under this resolve shall be expended on recommendation of the State Board of Education and approved by the Governor and Council; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This installation is recommended because of the long distances involved. With high voltage the service line losses would be very small. The wire sizes would be small and the installation costs much less than for low voltage distribution lines. Putting the wires underground would improve the appearance of the campus.
