IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Authorizing Waiver of Certain Requirements to Admit Dorothy M. Rubin of Bath to the General Practice of Law.

Supreme Judicial Court authorized to waiver bar requirements. Resolved: That the provision of the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 105, section 2, which requires that practicing attorneys of other states shall have been engaged in the active practice of law and a member of the bar of such other state for at least 3 years as qualifications for admission to the general practice of law in the State of Maine, on motion, shall be waived as to Dorothy M. Rubin, Esq. of Bath, Maine, and the Supreme Judicial Court shall have the authority to admit her to the general practice of law in this State providing that she meets all the remaining provisions of the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 105, section 2.
