STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Exemption from Taxation of Certain Property Owned by Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 91-A, § 10, sub-§ I, ¶ H, additional. Subsection I of section 10 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955, is amended by adding a new paragraph H, to read as follows :

‘H. Ponds, lakes, water courses, reservoirs, dams, conduits and pipes used in connection therewith and flowage rights and land used in connection therewith, owned and maintained by municipalities in this State for the benefit of inhabitants of this State without compensation therefor, if so held and maintained for the use and protection of the public welfare.’
