## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to Artificial Aids for Employees for Injuries under Workmen's Compensation Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 9, amended. The 4th sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 9 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The commission in its discretion may also require the employer to furnish, replace and renew when deemed necessary to the injured employee but not more than once each for an injury aforesaid, artificial limbs, eyes and, teeth, orthopedic appliances and physical aids made necessary by such injury.
