IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Employment of City Personnel in City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XVI, § 11-A, additional. Article XVI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is amended by adding a new section 11-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 11-A. Preference for employment to be given city inhabitants. In considering applications for employment, all municipal authorities empowered to employ personnel shall give preference, whenever practicable, to qualified persons who are inhabitants of the City of Lewiston, qualified to vote therein. The provisions of this section shall not be applicable to school teachers and other professional personnel.'
