Silsby, II, at a price not exceeding \$5 per copy, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian; and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$500 for this purpose.
