RESOLVE to Reimburse New Canada Plantation for Aid Extended to Adrien Saucier and Family.

New Canada Plantation; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 to be paid to New Canada Plantation, to reimburse said plantation for aid extended to Adrien Saucier and family.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

New Canada Plantation has been paying for the support of the Adrien Saucier family since the year 1941. It was discovered in the Spring of 1958 that the Saucier family lost their residence in New Canada in the 1940's. This can be verified by the Department of Health and Welfare, Division of State General Relief.
