RESOLVE, to Reimburse Mrs. George Dumond of New Canada Plantation for Beaver Damage.

Mrs. George Dumond; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$900 to be paid to Mrs. George Dumond of New Canada Plantation, as a full and final settlement of her claim against the State for damage to land by beavers.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Beavers damaged about 150 cords of soft wood (pulp and logs) or about 5 acres of land. Damage figured at \$6 a cord stumpage or about \$180 per acre total loss.
