STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Withdrawal of Town From School Supervisory Union.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 81, amended. Section 81 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 210 of the public laws of 1955 and section 41 of chapter 364 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, as follows:

'When a town having more than 75 teachers under its care and custody shall remove itself from an existing administrative unit composed of not more than 2 towns, the remaining town shall, with the consent of its school committee members and the State Board of Education, be treated as though said remaining town had more than 75 teachers under its care and custody, provided that said remaining town has more than 40 teachers under its care and custody.'
