STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Bounty on Bobcat in Certain Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 121, amended. The first sentence of section 121 of chapter 37, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a bounty of \$15 for every bobcat, loupcervier and Canada lynx which is killed within the State, except that the bounty in the counties of Aroostook, Penobscot, Piscataquis and Somerset shall be \$25, to be paid by the Treasurer of State to the person killing the same upon compliance with the following conditions.'
