HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 550, L. D. 785, Resolve, Permitting
Ice Fishing in Certain Ponds in Androscoggin and Kennebec
Counties.

Amend said Resolve by striking out the period at the end and
adding the following:

"; and be it further

Resolves, 1959, c. 42, amended.

Resolved: That chapter 42 of the resolves of 1959 be, and
hereby is, amended to read as follows:

'Fishing in Maranacook Lake; regulated. Resolved: That the
Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, author-
ized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Maranacook
Lake, in the Town of Winthrop and the Town of Readfield, Kennebec
County, to ice fishing for all fish except bass during February and
March. There shall be a daily bag limit of 5 trout which shall not
exceed a weight of 7-1/2 pounds.'"
