**RESOLVE, Permitting Ice Fishing in Certain Ponds in
Androscoggin and Kennebec Counties.**

Ice fishing in certain ponds; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to ice fishing under the general laws the following ponds:

Rack Pond, East Livermore, Androscoggin County ;
Round Pond, East Livermore, Androscoggin County ;
Turner Pond, East Livermore, Androscoggin County ;
Burgess Pond, Fayette, Kennebec County ;
Mud Pond, Fayette, Kennebec County ;

School House Pond, East Livermore, Androscoggin County, and Fayette, Kennebec County.
