## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Permitting Ice Fishing in Certain Ponds in Androscoggin and Kennebec Counties.

Ice fishing in certain ponds; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to ice fishing under the general laws the following ponds:

Rack Pond, East Livermore, Androscoggin County;

Round Pond, East Livermore, Androscoggin County;

Turner Pond, East Livermore, Androscoggin County;

Burgess Pond, Fayette, Kennebec County;

Mud Pond, Fayette, Kennebec County;

School House Pond, East Livermore, Androscoggin County, and Fayette, Kennebec County.
