RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Little Jim Pond, Somerset County.

Little Jim Pond; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Little Jim Pond, Jim Pond Township, T4, R5, Somerset County, to fishing with a daily limit of 5 fish in the aggregate. The use or possession of live fish as bait is prohibited.
