STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Crosby Pond, Franklin County.

Crosby Pond; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Crosby Pond, Coburn Gore, Franklin County, to fishing with a daily limit of 5 fish in the aggregate. The use or possession of live fish as bait is prohibited.
