## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to Records of State Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15, § 5-A, additional. Chapter 15 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 5-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 5-A. Records confidential. All criminal and administrative records of the State Police and the Bureau of Identification are declared to be confidential. Such records may be subpoenaed by a court of record.'
