RESOLVE, Providing State Pension for Philip Theriault, Jr. of Van Buren.

Philip Theriault, Jr.; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$60 per month be, and is, granted to Philip Theriault, Jr., of Van Buren, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1959 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Philip Theriault, Jr., age 15, was involved in a very serious automobile accident in 1957. He has had 3 major operations and has had one kidney removed. He is unable to attend school full time.
