**AN ACT Increasing Number of Medical Examiners for Somerset County.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 89, § 243, amended.** The 3rd sentence of section 243 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapters 283 and 284, and as repealed and replaced by section 78 of chapter 429, all of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows :

'The number of medical examiners so to be appointed shall be as follows: For the Counties of Franklin, Knox, Lincoln, Piscataquis, Sagadahoc ~~Somerset~~ and Waldo, 2 each; for the Counties of Hancock, Oxford and Washington, 3 each; for the Counties of Kennebec, ~~Somerset~~ and York, 4 each; for the Counties of Androscoggin and Aroostook, 5 each; for the Counties of Cumberland and Penobscot, 7 each; and they shall be appointed with reference to territorial distribution.'
