STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Contributions Under Old Age Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 281, amended. The 3rd and 4th paragraphs of section 281 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes are repealed and the following paragraph enacted in place thereof:

'On receipt of an application, the department may inquire into the financial ability and income of the children of the applicant and if it appears that any of the children can contribute toward the support of their parent, then the amount of aid shall be reduced in proportion to the amount that such child can contribute.'
