HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 555, L. D. 811, Bill, "An Act Creating Municipal Urban Renewal Authorities."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 14 of that part designated "Chapter 90-B" the following underlined paragraph:

'Whenever the closing or relocation of any public street or way is required by an urban renewal plan approved in accordance with section 5 and there is required in connection therewith a relocation of utility or common carrier pipe line facilities located in any public street or way, the municipal officers or board of selectmen, acting pursmant to chapter 50, may issue an appropriate order to the person owning or operating such facilities, and such person shall relocate the same promptly in accordance with such order, provided the authority shall pay such person the entire cost of such relocation. As used in this paragraph, the term "cost of relocation" shall include the entire amount paid by such person properly attributable to such relocation after deducting therefrom any increase in the value of the new facility and any salvage value derived from the old facility.'
