STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for a Library at Washington State Teachers' College.

Library at Washington State Teachers' College; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$99,400 in favor of Washington State Teachers' College for the construction of a library. Funds appropriated under this resolve shall be expended on recommendation of the State Board of Education and approved by the Governor and Council; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The present library is housed in one room in the classroom building. It contains approximately 10,000 volumes with double rows of books on many of the shelves. In order to meet accreditation standards, library space and facilities must be greatly expanded and improved, and it is proposed that a library wing be made a part of a new classroom-library-auditorium building.
