**RESOLVE, in Favor of a Lunchroom in the Administration Building at
Washington State Teachers' College.**

Lunchroom in the Administration Building at Washington State Teachers' College; appropriation. Resolve: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$8,600 in favor of Washington State Teachers' College for the installation of a lunchroom in the Administration Building. Funds appropriated under this resolve shall be expended on recommendation of the State Board of Education and approved by the Governor and Council; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There is now no adequate provision for serving hot lunches to campus school pupils who attend school in the Administration Building. This project would provide kitchen and serving facilities for hot lunches not only for campus school pupils but also for college students who commute.
