COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 291, L. D. 815, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Addition of the Towns of Cushing, Rockport, St. George, Thomaston and Warren to School Administrative District No. 5."

Amend said Bill by inserting before "AGREEMENT FOR THE TOWNS OF CUSHING, ROCKPORT, ST. GEORGE, THOMASTON AND WARREN TO JOIN SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT NO. 5" the following paragraph:

'In the event that one or more of the administrative units named herein fails to approve any of the articles required to be voted upon by this act, the Maine School District Commission is authorized to accept new applications from the administrative units having voted to accept this act. The commission is further authorized to order the administrative units having approved the act and School Administrative District No. 5 to vote on articles prepared by the commission in the same tenor as the articles heretofore set out in this act.'
