RESOLVE, Providing for Retirement Benefit Increase for Mary E. C. Bridgham of Jonesboro.

Mary E. C. Bridgham; retirement benefit increased. Resolved: That the retirement benefit now being paid to Mary E. C. Bridgham of Jonesboro, under the provisions of the Revised Statutes, chapter 63-A, be increased from \$5.73 monthly to \$25 monthly.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mary Bridgham retired under the so-called "10-year vested right" provision of the law on April 6, 1954. She was born on June 30, 1884. The amount of benefit payable to her under this provision of the law is entirely inadequate to meet her needs.
