STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Surplus Funds by Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 30-A, repealed and replaced. Section 30-A of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 262 of the public laws of 1955, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 30-A. Surplus funds. A county may authorize the transfer of an amount from unencumbered surplus funds at the end of any fiscal year for the purpose of reducing the tax levy in the ensuing year or to supplement estimated revenues for the same purpose.'
