RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for Mosquito and Fly Control.

Mosquito and fly control; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960 and \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961 to be expended for advice and leadership under chapter 25, sections 157 to 159, to groups or individuals desiring to carry out mosquito, black-fly and green-head fly control.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The law directs the Health and Welfare Department to exterminate mosquitoes and flies and there is no appropriation set up for this purpose.
