RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Horne Pond, Limington, York County.

Fishing in Horne Pond; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Horne Pond in Limington, York County to ice fishing from the time ice forms in the fall until March 31st, for all fish except bass, salmon and trout.
