## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to Definition of Occupational Disease.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 59, amended. Section 59 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 59. Definition of "occupational disease". Whenever used in this law, the term "occupational disease" shall be construed to mean only a disease set forth in section 69 which is due to eauses and conditions which are characteristic of and peculiar to a particular trade, occupation, process or employment and which arises out of and in the course of employment any of the diseases specifically enumerated in section 69 and any and all other diseases or disabilities having a direct casual connection to the conditions under which the work is performed and appearing to have had its origin as a result of the employment and to have flowed from that source as a natural consequence though it need not have been expected or foreseen.'
