STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Naming Maine Mountains the "Longfellow Mountains of Maine".

Preamble. Whereas, the State of Maine has been recognized as one of the foremost vacation states; and

Whereas, the mountains in Maine provide a major source of the state's recreational activity; and

Whereas, there is a need in promotional writing and advertising for a descriptive term with which to generally designate such mountains; now, therefore, be it

"Longfellow Mountains of Maine"; designated. Resolved: That those mountains within this State included in, and being part of, the Appalachian Mountain Range shall be officially named, and henceforth referred to, as the "Longfellow Mountains of Maine".
