COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 596, L. D. 842, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Salary and Travel of Representatives of Indian Tribes to the Legislature."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words "and Travel"

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 10, §2, amended. The last paragraph of section 2 of chapter 10 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The member of the Indian tribe elected by it to represent the tribe at the biennial assembly of the Legislature shall receive a compensation of \$200 \$250 for such attendance.'"
